FR. SEBASTIAN'S REFLECTIONS

In the first reading (Acts 9:26-31) Paul (formerly known as Saul) arrived Jerusalem after his encounter with God on his way to Damascus. Only Barnabas was courageous enough to introduce him to the early Christian community where he was later welcomed. His past record as a persecutor was eventually overcome by the fraternal love he was shown. The impact of Paul's conversion was felt across the early Christian community as the Church thrived in peace and the number of believers increased.

The second reading (1 John 3:18-24) reminds us of the impact of love. It is not a passive verb, but an active one. Our love for God and neighbor should not remain hidden in our hearts. It is one that drives us to action, prayer, good works, compassion and requires a response. God loved us first by reaching out to us. We cannot remain indifferent to that call from God. We should love back.

In the Gospel (John 15:1-8) Jesus calls us the "branches of the vine". God the father is the vine grower, and we require pruning. A branch can only remain relevant and green if it remains part of the vine. Once it is cut off, it shrinks and wilts. We are reminded that our ministry, family, faith and fruitfulness, is tied to remaining part of Christ, the true vine. God's glory will be made manifest when we bear fruit and become stronger members of the Apostolic family. Amen.


